Notice to Witness—Revised

Important

You must appear as a witness at a hearing of the Workers' Compensation Board. The attached summons tells you where and when. Please read this immediately.

Information for witnesses

1. The law says all witnesses must attend.

The Workers' Compensation Board investigates accidents that happen on the job and has the same powers as a court (see Section 81(a) of the *Workers Compensation Act*). When you are summoned as a witness, you must attend the hearing and give your evidence under oath.

You can be charged with contempt of court if you miss this hearing without a lawful reason. If you have a lawful reason you can't attend, you must let the Board know as soon as possible.

2. You may have to miss work.

You must appear at the time and place listed on the attached summons and stay as long as you are needed.

3. The Board will pay your expenses.

The money attached to the summons is to cover your expenses to attend the hearing. If you lose any pay for the time you are a witness, the Board may also pay part of your wages up to a maximum set by the Board.
