- You also rated highly for having clear reporting systems

Recommended actions

To achieve a 100 per cent rating, we recommend that you attend to the responsibilities marked as 'urgent' in this report. Then gradually work through all the other responsibilities identified.

In a separate document, we propose to deliver a 'good governance' training session for all your Board members. Meantime, we are confident you will find the advice in this report useful for raising your governance standards.
